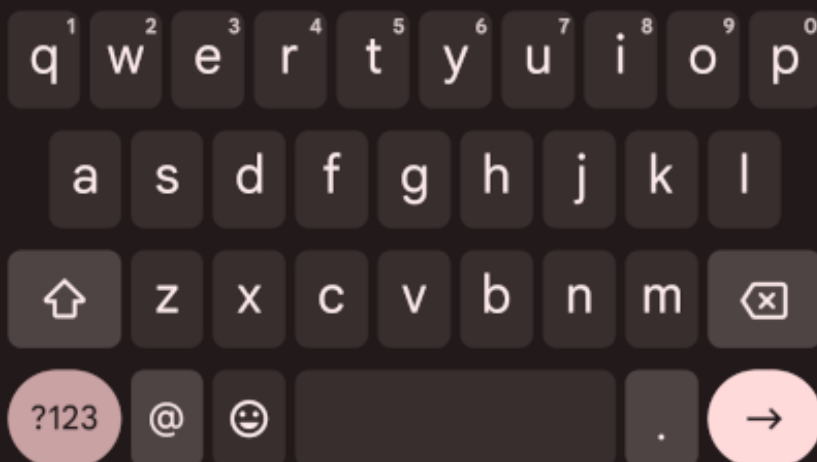

Lawrence Public Schools may see:

- Model
- Serial number
- Operating system
- Work apps
- Owner
- Device name
- Manufacturer
- Phone number for corporate devices
- Your company can grant permissions to work applications which may include camera, microphone, and location permissions.

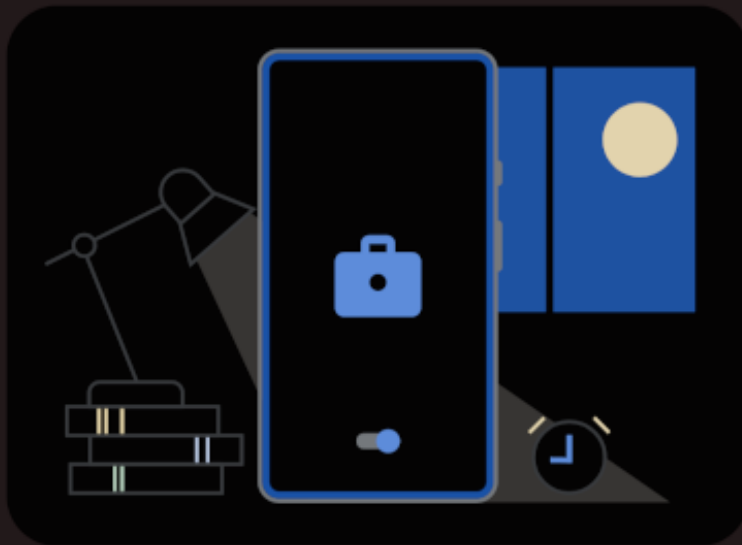

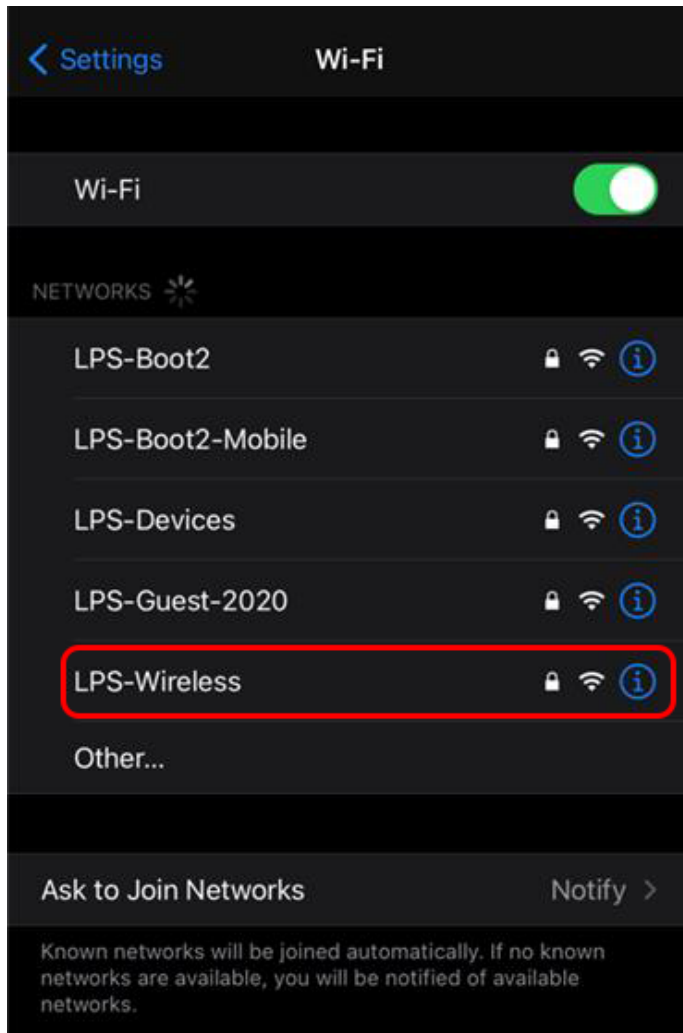

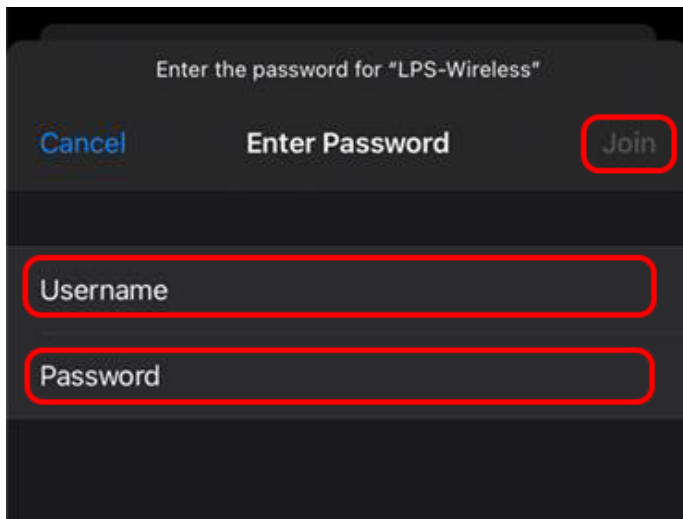

Connecting with an iOS device (Apple iPhone, iPad)

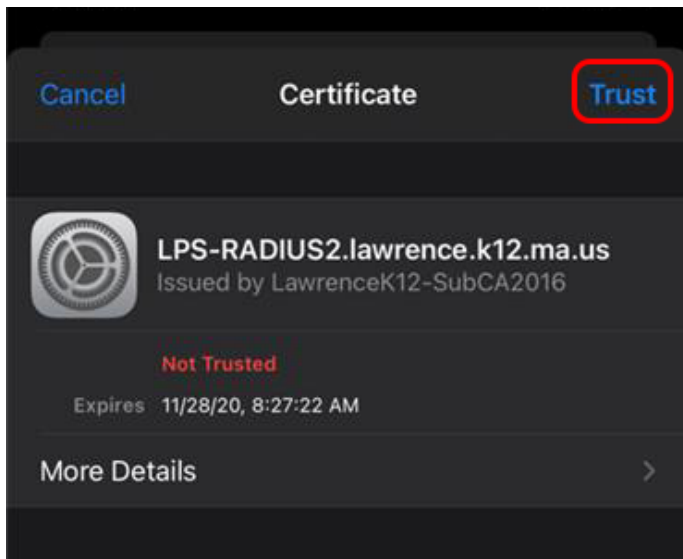
1. Select **LPS-Wireless** from the list of available networks.



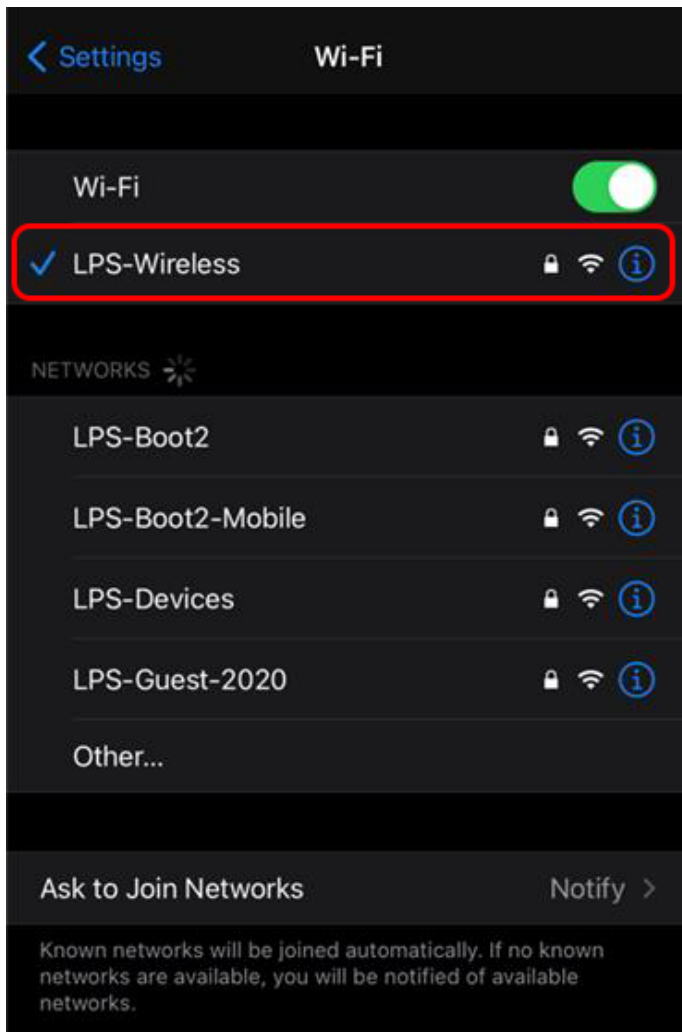
2. A login window will appear. Log in using your LPS account. The **Username** will be written as **firstname.lastname@Lawrence.K12.MA.US** where **firstname.lastname** will be your LPS account name.
3. Tap on **Join** .



4. A window will appear asking to trust the certificate for **LPS-RADIUS2.lawrence.k12.ma.us** . Tap on **Trust** .



5. A check-mark will appear next to **LPS-Wireless** when connected to the network.
